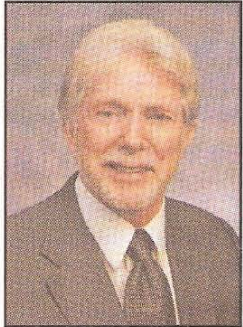


# FBI leaders praise LEJA professor's book

Cronkhite's "Criminal Justice Administration: Strategies for the 21st Century," was published in 2008 by Jones and Bartlett Publishers.

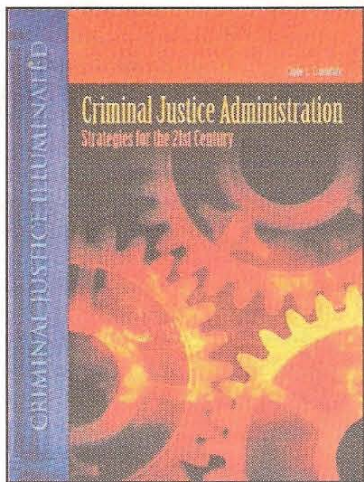

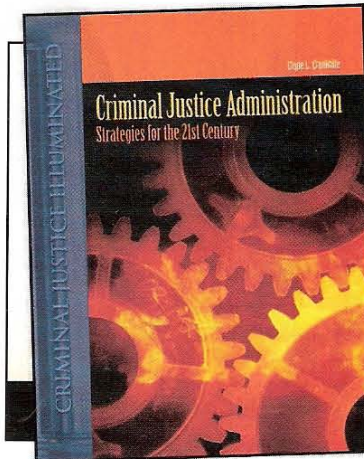
